SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Prizegiving Trial, Tweed's Farm , Carncastle

1. The Sporting Trials Car Club will organise a Club Trial on **28th October 2017**
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd., these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit number: TBA
4. The event is a round of the STCC Club Championships and is open to all fully elected members of the organising club.
5. Members of NPTCC and other GB Trials Clubs are invited to enter and compete for the Kincraft Trophy which will be presented at the Prizegiving Dinner.
6. All drivers may be required to produce a club membership card.
7. Scrutineering starts at **09.30am**. Any competitor not signed on by **10.15am** may be excluded. First car starts at 10.30am.
8. The only tyres permitted for the event will be Vredestein T Trac 2, Maxxis MA510N and Nankang CX688.
9. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 5 sections on private land. Details of the sections will be issued at signing on. The number of rounds will be related to the weather and the size of entry. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills.
10. The event will consist of three classes (A, B and C) and all cars must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and with the National Trials Car Formula.
 - Class A - Experts as seeded by the Club
 - Class B - Semi-Experts as seeded by the Club
 - Class C - Novices as seeded by the club. Novice defined as a competitor not having 2 years and 12 events experience
11. The entry list opens on publication and closes on the **Wednesday** prior to the trial date. **The entry fee is £25.00**. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 60 and the minimum 10. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting. Eligible entries will be accepted upon receipt. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date.
14. Other Club Officials are: -

15. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
16. Appeals and Protests: MSA regulations C5, C6 and C7 apply. However, in the first instance all appeals and protests during a trial should be made to the Clerk of the Course who in turn should refer them *via* the Secretary or Chairman to the Appeals Committee for consideration. In this event the Club Chairman will convene the Appeals Committee which shall include appropriate Club personnel, a Club Steward and the Clerk of the Course. The Appeals Committee should meet as soon as possible after the trial to consider such protests and appeals. Publication of results for the trial in question will be deferred pending the decision of the Appeals Committee. The decision of the Appeals Committee will be final. No argument will be entered into regarding a Marshals decision. Any Competitor breaking this Rule will be given a maximum "12 mark plus lowest score penalty" on that section. Further dispute with the Marshal will result in immediate disqualification from the event. Competitors may discuss decisions with the Clerk of the Course up until the results have been made final.
17. Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot prior to the event.
18. Number cards issued by the organisers will identify competitors.
19. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations.
20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following, which is modified:
T 5.2.1: Start hills for each round will be notified at signing on and competitors will run in numerical order within each group throughout the event unless instructed otherwise by an official.
21. A brake & differential test may be made before the start of the event.
22. A minimum tyre pressure will be applied on the day as follows:
Class A, Reference pressure
Class B and Class C , reference pressure less 1psi
The Reference Pressure will be determined by the weather/ground condition on the day and will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Checks will be carried out to check compliance
23. **No person may drive or be a passenger in a competing car on the site unless they have signed the clubs official indemnity form. In the case of people who ignore this request, they may be disqualified and asked to leave the site.**
24. Cars may be double driven.
25. Important Notice
As the Clerk of the Course is responsible for the safe running of the trial, no Marshall or Competitor may change a section without the permission of the Clerk of the Course.

Follow M2, A57 and A8 to Larne - 23 min (20.1 mi)

Take Ballymullock Rd and Sallagh Rd to Feystown Rd - 12 min (6.3 mi)

Trial site (93 Feystown Rd, Larne BT40) is on left - 0.9 mi

Route Details

Dunsilly Hotel, 20 Dunsilly Rd, Antrim BT41 2JH

Continue to A26 - 54 s (0.2 mi)

Head south - Partial restricted-usage road - 0.2 mi

Turn right towards A26 - 98 ft

Follow M2, A57 and A8 to Larne - 23 min (20.1 mi)

Turn right onto A26 - 0.3 mi

At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto the M2 slip road to Belfast/Antrim Area Hospital - 0.5 mi

Continue onto M2 - 6.7 mi

At junction 5, take the A57 exit to Templepatrick - 0.4 mi

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Ballyclare Rd/A57 - Continue to follow A57 - 5.7 mi

At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto the A8 slip road - 0.2 mi

Merge onto A8 - 6.0 mi

At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Shanes Hill Rd/A36 - 0.3 mi

Take Ballymullock Rd and Sallagh Rd to Feystown Rd - 12 min (6.3 mi)

Slight right towards Deerpark Rd - 0.3 mi

Turn right onto Deerpark Rd - 0.7 mi

Continue onto Ballyhampton Rd - 397 ft

Slight left onto Ballymullock Rd - 2.4 mi

Turn left onto Sallagh Rd - 2.0 mi

Turn left onto Feystown Rd

Destination will be on the left - 0.9 mi
